As an internal reviewer, you contribute to quality assurance of our publications, with the goal of making new ideas in Swiss foreign policy visible.

What we expect:

- You take over 1–2 reviews of foraus publications per year, including content evaluation of drafts, providing constructive feedback to authors, and coordinating the revision process (multiple loops of feedback with the authors).
- You are the main point of contact for the authors regarding content and support them throughout the entire writing process (which can take several months).
- Time required: approx. 3-6 hours per review (plus communication and coordination with the authors).

We are looking for people:

- who have ideally already published work for foraus, or who have experience in Think tank work (as distinct from purely academic work) and voluntary work.
- who are keen to contribute to the quality and credibility of foraus publications.
- with specialist knowledge of Swiss foreign policy.

- the opportunity to contribute your ideas and expertise,
- as well as the development of key skills in writing, coaching, and project management to help you gain a voice in public debate.
